With our well control response equipment staged in Port Harcourt along with local support, Wild Well can respond quickly to our clients' locations in Nigeria.

PERSONNEL SUPPORT

Wild Well is prepared to support a response in Nigeria with experienced personnel and local support. Our local support group can assist with obtaining work visas and providing local transportation/security for Expat (non-wellsite) related travel and lodging.

EQUIPMENT

As part of our capabilities in Nigeria, Wild Well has equipment staged in Port Harcourt. Our full suite of firefighting equipment and well control response kit is comprised of firefighting pumps, hydraulic conventional Athey wagon with accessories, and fully-stocked hose and monitor containers. The equipment receives periodic maintenance and testing in accordance with Wild Well's Quality Control program. We maintain an appropriate inventory of spare parts for all equipment in a secure storage facility with 24-hour access.

DEPLOYMENT PLANS

Wild Well has established deployment plans for mobilization in Nigeria. These include: Single point contact with local support group, Wild Well, and client Load out equipment (cranes, forklifts, etc.) and personnel, available 24/7 Certified truck availability for immediate load out All necessary permits obtained Evaluation and recommendation of routes, considering road conditions and other factors Tracking of equipment movement and ETA updates for effective communication
